

Ask and answer in Python

This code asks a question and then answers.

```
print "hello"
name=raw_input("What is your name?")
print "hello ", name
print "how are you?"
```

```
print "hello"
answer=input("What is 4+5?")
if answer==9:
    print "correct"
else:
    print "sorry, wrong"
```

This code asks for an answer and then gives a different response depending on the answer given.

We use `input()` for numbers and `raw_input()` for text (words).

```
score=0
answer=input("what is 4+5?")
if answer==9:
    print "correct"
    score=score+1
else:
    print "sorry, wrong."

answer=input("What is 3+7?")
if answer==10:
    print "correct"
    score=score+1
else:
    print "sorry, wrong."

print "your score is ", score
```

Extend your program to make a quiz - each question should follow the same pattern.

Add one to the score if the question is answered right.

Then print out the final score at the end.
