

Quickshape flowers



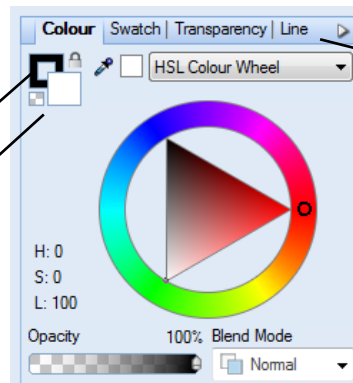
Quickshapes flyout - most shapes have sliders to change their look - have a play



Use the controls to change the colour of the line and fill of your shapes. Click the line or fill first, then the colour you want.

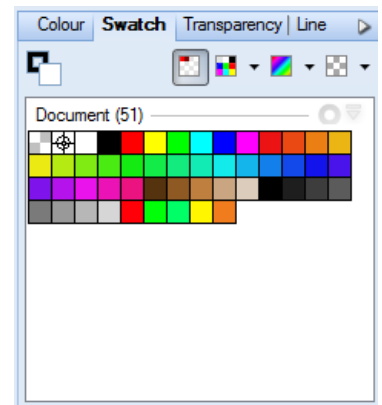
Line colour

Line controls are here if you want to make it thicker or dotted

The swatch tab gives solid colours and also access to the gradient fill tool



To draw a flower


In the Startup Wizard, choose Start New Drawing, select a page size of your choice and click OK.


On the Drawing toolbar, click the  Pen Tool.

Click once on the page to begin the line, and then, click and drag to create a short, curved line.

Press the Esc key to finish the line. With the line selected, on the Line tab, increase the line width to 10pt.



On the Drawing toolbar, on the QuickShapes flyout, click the  Quick Petal. Press and hold the Shift key while dragging on your page to draw the flower. Use the sliders on each side to change the appearance of your flower.

Now for the leaves. On the Drawing toolbar, in the QuickShapes flyout, click the  Quick Heart. Drag on your page to draw the heart, and drag the left node down to the bottom. You can rotate by dragging near a corner handle.
